PROMISING PERFORMANCE FOR DS PENSKE DURING THE FIRST ROUND OF THE GEN 3 ERA IN MEXICO CITY

Mexico City, Mexico: Round 1 ABB Formula E FIA World Championship.

Mexico City, Mexico – DS PENSKE hit the track at the famous Circuit Hermanos Rodriguez for the first race of Season 9 of the ABB FIA Formula E World Championship. The team was extremely eager to put the new DS E-TENSE FE23 through its paces during Round 1 in Mexico.

After running in the top of both FP1 and FP2, both drivers had a tough qualifying having both their fast laps skuttled by traffic. The result put JEV P11 and Stoffel P14 on the starting grid. The team bounced back having a solid run with Stoffel finishing 10th and JEV disappointingly dropping to 12th with a battery issue on the last lap after running in the top 10 all race long.

Things started quite well in free practice with both cars being top-5 each sessions. The car felt very good, but during qualifying we could not get a clean lap when we needed it due to traffic. So we were not able to capitalize on the good performance from free practice.

Starting from 14th position, I knew that it would not be simple. The race had a lot of cautions and safety car periods. Ultimately, it was very difficult to overtake and I was not able to improve my position better than 10th.'
